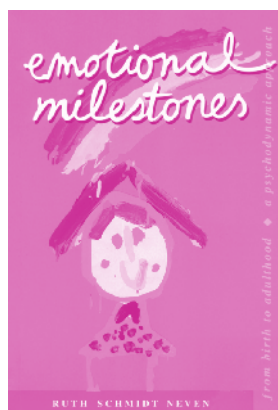

The *Foundation Course* has been run for over a decade in Melbourne. It is also run throughout Australia and overseas most recently at the University of Cambridge *Child Wellbeing Forum*.

The course has established a reputation for making psychodynamic ideas accessible

and highly practical for ALL professionals who work with children, adolescents and parents in a wide range of settings. These include social workers, psychologists, maternal and child health nurses, kindergarten and child care workers, teachers, doctors and community workers. The *Foundation Course* is devised and run by Ruth Schmidt Neven, Director of the Centre for Child and Family Development and formerly inaugural chief psychotherapist at the Royal Children's Hospital. Her book *Emotional Milestones: From Birth to Adulthood* is essential reading for the Course and is included in the fee. The book published in Australia by ACER and in the UK, has been described as making a major contribution to child health. A key concept is that the child's behaviour has meaning and is always a communication. The *Foundation Course* applies this understanding to help professionals work more effectively with children, parents

and young people.

FOUNDATION COURSE STAFF

The *Foundation Course* is devised and run by Ruth Schmidt Neven PhD. Ruth is a child psychotherapist, psychologist and researcher and the author of numerous books and papers.

LEARNING METHOD

Learning is both factual and experiential and includes ample opportunities for discussion. Participants are encouraged to bring case material from their own work settings.

The Course takes place from 9-5 on Thursday and 9-4 on Friday. It is very intensive and participants must be able to attend **ALL** the presentations on both days.

The *Foundation Course* is recognised as providing Continuing Professional Education.

FURTHER TRAINING

The Advanced Studies in Child and Family Development and the two year Training in Psychodynamic Counselling with Children, Parents, Families and the Community.

Participants who complete the *Foundation Course* are eligible to proceed to the *Advanced Studies in Child and Family Development*. This one year intensive programme aims to extend and develop the skills and expertise of all professionals who work with children, parents and families.

The *Advanced Studies in Child and Family Development* commences in April 2011. Following satisfactory completion of the *Advanced Studies*, participants can apply to undertake the *Training in Psychodynamic Counselling*.
